ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE OF STATE FUNDED EXEMPTED PROJECTS

Under Indiana code IC 13-12-4-5, the Indiana Department of Transportation has determined certain types of projects to be exempt from the State Environmental Policy Act requirements outlined in 327 IAC 11. As this project has been determined to be excluded from the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements outlined in 40 CFR 1502.22 (b) it meets the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act. As long as funding, approval, and permitting requirements remain the same as reported on this form, at letting this project is exempted under 327 IAC 11-1-3, sec. 3. (e) (1). The following table demonstrates the exemptions agreed upon by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management and the Governor of the State of Indiana in accordance with 327 IAC 11, and under the authority of IC 13-12-4 and 13-14-8.

SCOPE OF WORK

INDOT and IDOA recognize that state-owned excess right-of-way exists at various locations throughout the state. This land provides no function to the state highway system in terms of serviceability or maintenance, and prohibits development of the property for productive use for residential, commercial, agricultural, or other private or public use.

Additionally, state-ownership of land may reduce the availability of real estate that is subject to property taxation; revenue which could benefit the community. Selling such excess parcels of land would benefit the above causes, as well as providing the potential for additional revenue to the state from the proceeds of the sale.

Parcel 51 is located just northeast of US 31 at 4A Road in Marshall County, Indiana. Parcel 51 is approximately 6.5 acres.

Statements of Disclosure:

Above-Ground Summary: With regard to above-ground resources, this parcel was included in the studies for INDOT Des. No. 9405230, the US 31 Plymouth to South Bend project. As can be seen from the attached excerpted historic properties report (HPR) pages and the project's area of potential effects (APE) map, the identification efforts for the project did not identify any National Register eligible or listed properties on or adjacent this parcel. As can be seen on the attached mapping with aerial photography from 2016, the only Indiana Historic Sites and Structures Inventory (IHSSI) property located near this parcel was a "contributing" rated property: 099-342-05020. It was demolished as part of the US 31 project. The parcel is primarily fallow land with some wooded scrub brush vegetation. The only items that might be present on this parcel are utility poles and lines, and wire fences. We do not think that this parcel contains any historic sites or structures that its sale will impact any historic properties. No further abovegroundwork is recommended prior to the sale of this parcel.

Archaeology Summary: Excess parcel 5265-51 was acquired during the purchasing of r/w for US 31 Plymouth to South Bend in 2011. It is rectangular in shape and approximately 6.5 acres in size. A farmhouse and associated buildings stood on the parcel until all structures were demolished sometime between 2012 and 2014. A borrow area, filled with water, is shown to be in the middle of the parcel in 2014 but by 2016 it had been partially filled in. A Digital Elevation Model (DEM) still reveals this borrow area to be lower than the land surrounding it (Figure 1). Streetview imagery from August 2019 (Figure 2) depicts a graded and contoured surface with



fill material visible through the grass. According to SHAARD GIS, site 12-Mr-416 lies approximately 30m north of this parcel. This site is recorded as a disturbed historic farmstead ineligible for listing on the NRHP; the site will not be impacted by the sale of this parcel. Due to disturbances from demolition, construction, borrow, and filling activities, an archaeological reconnaissance does not appear warranted, and it is recommended that the sale of excess parcel 5265-51 be allowed to proceed without additional archeological study.

Pursuant to Indiana Code 14-21-1-14, the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology ("INDNR-DHPA") has reviewed your review request submittal form, with enclosures, dated June 18, 2020, which we received the same day, for the above indicated project in North Township, Marshall County, Indiana.

Relying on the information you provided with your excess parcel historic sites and structures screening form, it does not appear that Excess Parcel No. 51, located immediately to the east of current US 31, west of Maple Road and a short distance north of 4A Road, contains a structure that could be eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places ("NRHP") or the Indiana Register of Historic Sites and Structures ("IRHSS").

Additionally, based on the documentation available to INDNR-DHPA, we have not identified any currently known archaeological resources listed or eligible for inclusion in the NRHP or IRHSS within Excess Parcel No. 51. Archaeological site 12-Mr-0416 is immediately north of Excess Parcel No. 51, but will not be impacted by the sale of the parcel. It is our understanding that the parcel has been disturbed in the past by borrow pit activities. No archaeological work is required.

Accordingly, we do not believe that Excess Parcel No. 51, LA Code 5265, in North Township, Marshall County, contains a historic site or a historic structure.

If any archaeological artifacts, features, or human remains are uncovered during construction, state law (Indiana Code 14-21-1-27 and -29) requires that the discovery must be reported to INDNR-DHPA within two (2) business days. In that event, please call (317) 232-1646.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Historic Property Report documents the methodology and determinations of eligibility of historic properties for listing in the National Register of Historic Places as part of the Section 106 process for the U.S. 31 Plymouth to South Bend Study. LA Code 5265 Parcel 51 is located in the northeast quadrant of US 31 and 4A Road in Marshall County. LA Code 5265 Parcel 43, which is 0.24 mile south of the subject parcel, was cleared in an RFI dated January 12, 2018. RFI_LA 5265-43_US 31_Marshall County_Signed01.22.2018_mm.pdf

A review of the 0.5 mile search radius maps for Infrastructure, Water Resources, Mining/Mineral Exploration, Hazardous Material Concerns, and Ecological (to include endangered bat species) GIS layers in 2018 indicated that no impacts were found to the 5265-43 except for two water resources inside the parcel. A review of the 0.5 mile search radius maps for LA 5265 Parcel 51 indicated the presence of Infrastructure, Water Resources, and Hazardous Material Concerns within the 0.5 mile search radius, but not within or adjacent to the subject parcel (maps attached). In addition, no bat or other ETR species were noted within or adjacent to the subject parcel. No impacts are expected.




LA PAZ QUADRANGLE INDIANA 7.5 MINUTE SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)






