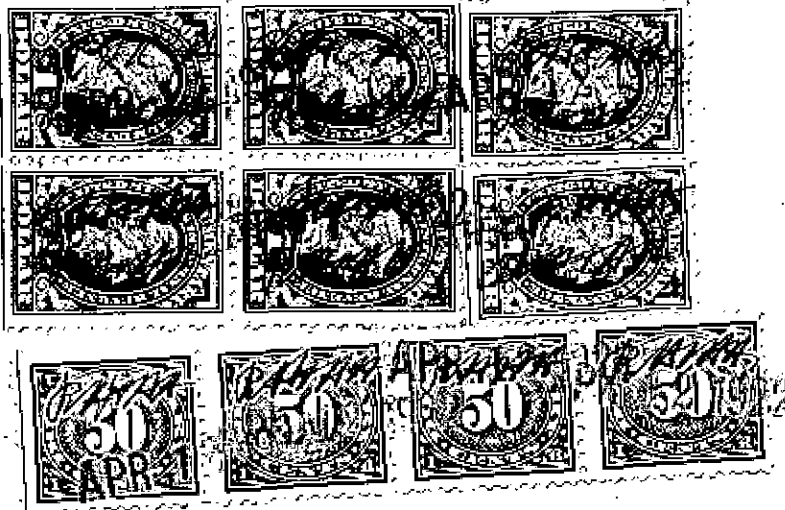

All that part and parcel of One Hundred acres of land off of the West side of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twenty-five (25) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Six (6) East, which lies South of the middle of the the old Indianapolis and Pendleton Highway, ( Shown on former deeds as Pendleton and Indianapolis State Road), said land being more particularly described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Six (6) East and running thence East Seventeen Hundred fifteen (1715) feet, thence North Twenty one Hundred Twenty seven (2127) feet to the center line of the Pendleton and Indianapolis State Road, thence Southwestwardly with the center of said Road with its meanderings Eighteen Hundred Thirty-four (1834) feet to the West line of said Quarter section at a point Thirteen Hundred Forty-three (1343) feet North of the place of beginning, thence South Thirteen Hundred Forty-three (1343) to the place of beginning, containing Sixty-five acres more or less. ✓
